The City of Huntsville, Department of Parking & Public Transit, is holding its annual Public Hearing concerning ADA Paratransit Plan *in coordination with* a Service Reduction Public Hearing on Thursday, January 3, 2008 at 5 p.m. in the City of Huntsville, Department of Parking & Public Transit, 2nd floor Conference Room, 500 B Church Street.

Notice is hereby given that the City of Huntsville, Department of Parking & Public Transit, is considering reducing the Downtown Weekend Shuttle by one. Current operations have this route running two buses on Friday and Saturday evenings between 7:00 p.m. and 2:00 a.m. at no cost to the public. Consideration is being given to reduce this service to one bus per evening beginning Friday, January 18, 2008.

The service reduction public hearing is being held as required by FTA Circular 9030.1c, Ch. V, Section 5.o, and the Department of Transportation's 49 U.S.C. 5307 (d) (1) (I), as amended, and the City of Huntsville, Department of Parking & Public Transit Public Comment Policies.

The ADA public hearing is being held as required by the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, as amended, and the Department of Transportation's 49 C.F.R. parts 27, 37 and 38, as amended.
