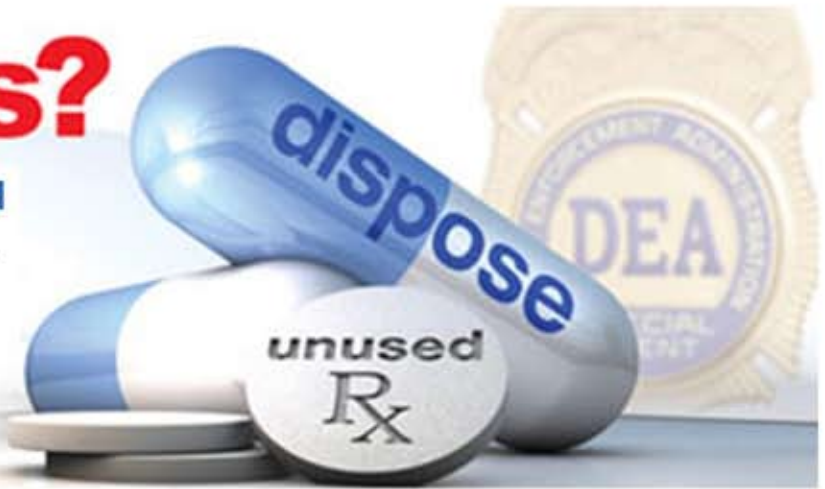

Huntsville Police, U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA), Partnership for a Drug-Free Community, Operation Green Team, the Solid Waste Disposal Authority (SWDA) and Covanta Huntsville invite you to safely dispose of any expired or unwanted medications.

- Nationally, teenage prescription drug abuse is rapidly increasing, and your family **medicine cabinet could become a teenager's best supplier.**
- Help protect the environment. Collection programs greatly reduce the chance of **medicines entering our water supply!**
- This program is **completely confidential.** No personal information will be collected. Please remove or black out all labels before arriving.
- **Drop off your medications at the drive-thru between 10:00am – 2:00pm.** Place unwanted medications directly in disposal box. Volunteers and law enforcement officers will be present to ensure safe and legal collection. Medications will be disposed of by the SWDA and Covanta Huntsville.
